The step by step apprenticeship journey

Step 1 - Check out the role

Visit our website for all our current vacancies and read the job descriptions.

Step 2 - Application form

Complete all sections and tell us why you're interested. We don't accept CVs so don't worry about putting one together. Apprentice roles get a lot of applications so take your time to make sure yours is the best it can be.

Step 3 - Shortlisting and interview

If you're shortlisted, we'll invite you to an interview. During the interview you'll be scored against our four values; **Caring, Confident, United and Ambitious.** We'll tell you more about these on our website.

Step 4 - Being offered a contract

If you're successful at the interview, you'll receive a fixed term contract with us, subject to pre-employment checks.

Step 5 - Your induction

You'll attend an induction and complete a health and safety sessions at our Stores unit in Normanton.

Step 6 - Further support

You'll work with the Learning and Development Team to spot any skill gaps and boost your personal growth.

Step 7 - End point assessment

After completing your end point assessment you'll have the skills and experience to grow and develop your career.

Where can an apprenticeship take you?

"At 22, I decided to learn a trade and started a four-year electrical installation apprenticeship. I wanted to earn while I learned, gaining hands-on experience from day one starting with a refurbishment of an Independent Living Scheme.

Over the years, I've worked on installations, repairs and testing which built my confidence and practical skills. College block placements helped me achieve my Level 3 Electrotechnical qualification and the support from mentors made a huge difference. They encouraged me to take ownership while being there to guide me.

Now, I've completed my apprenticeship I work full-time as a Senior Electrician. I'm proud of how far I've come and excited for what's next.
